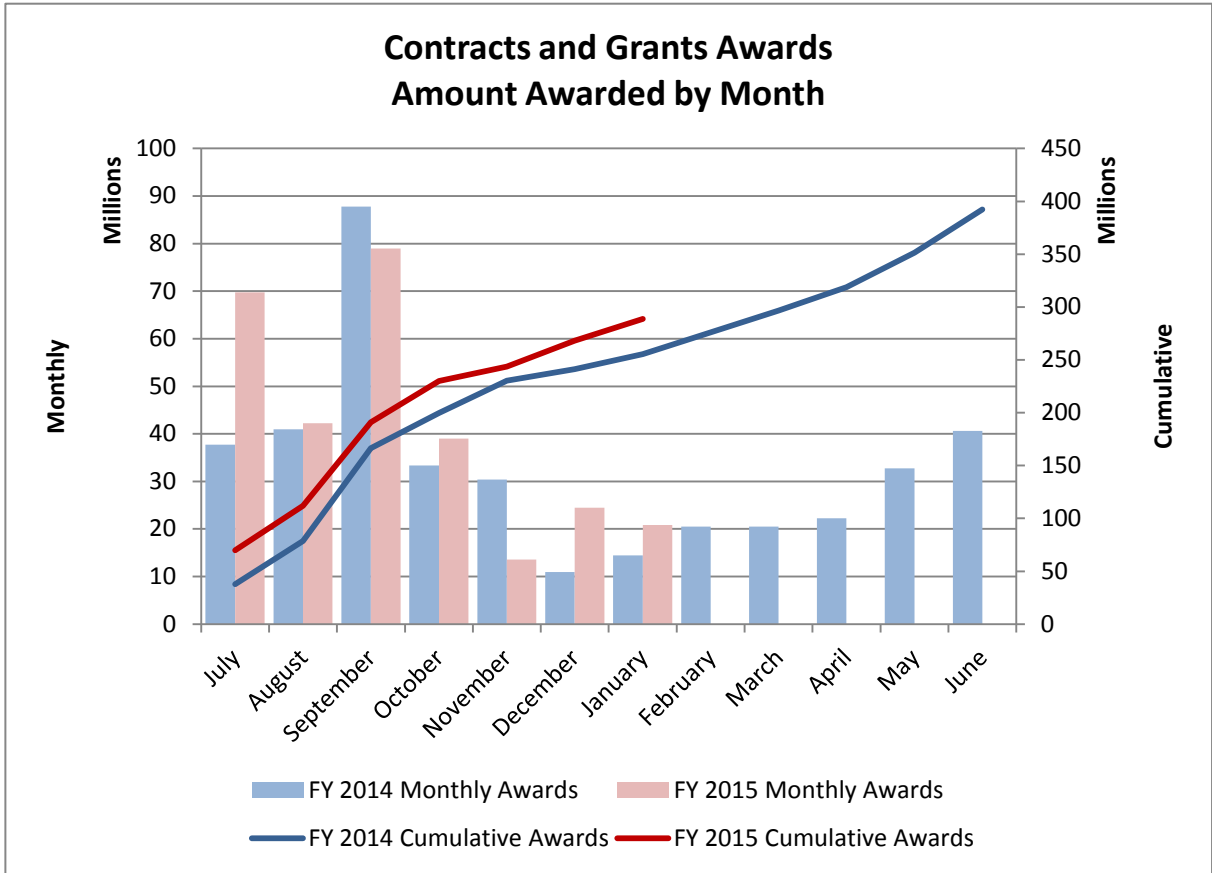
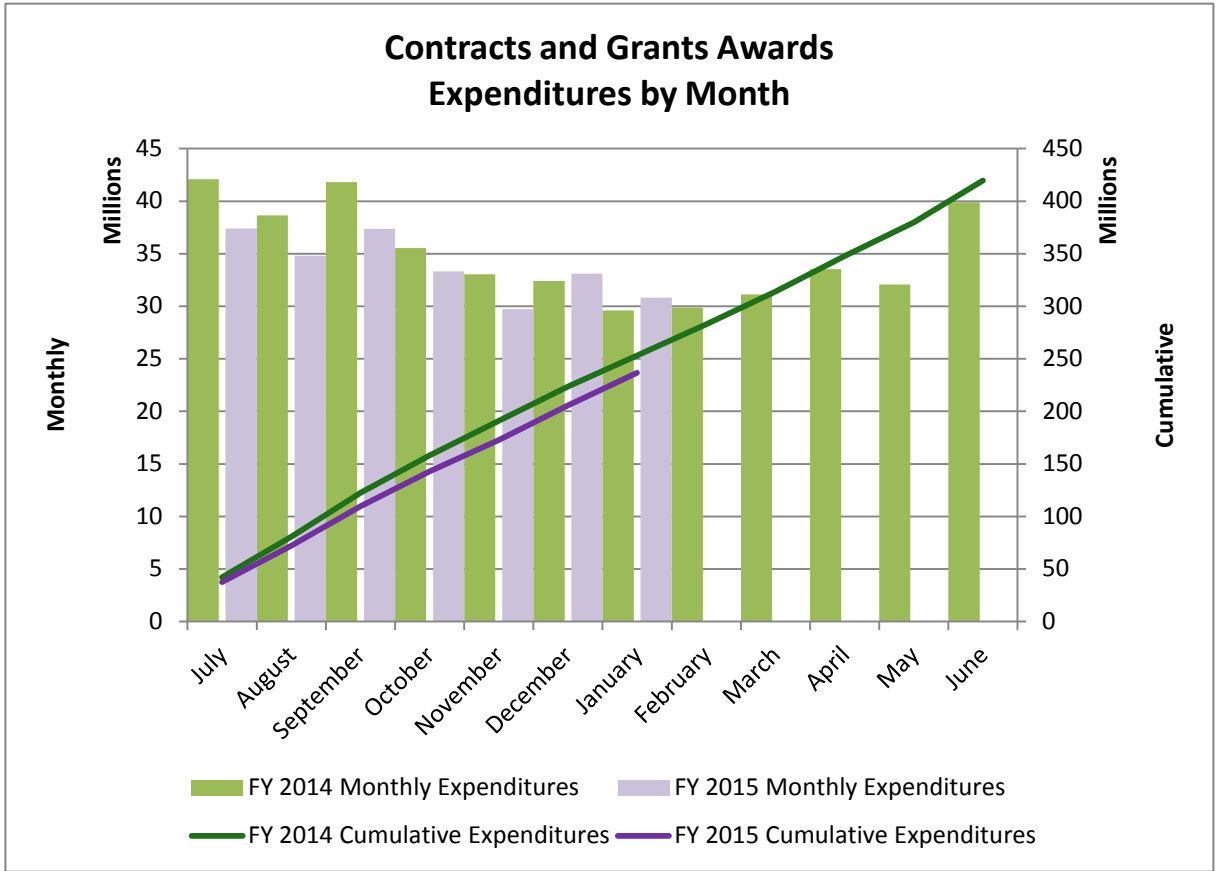


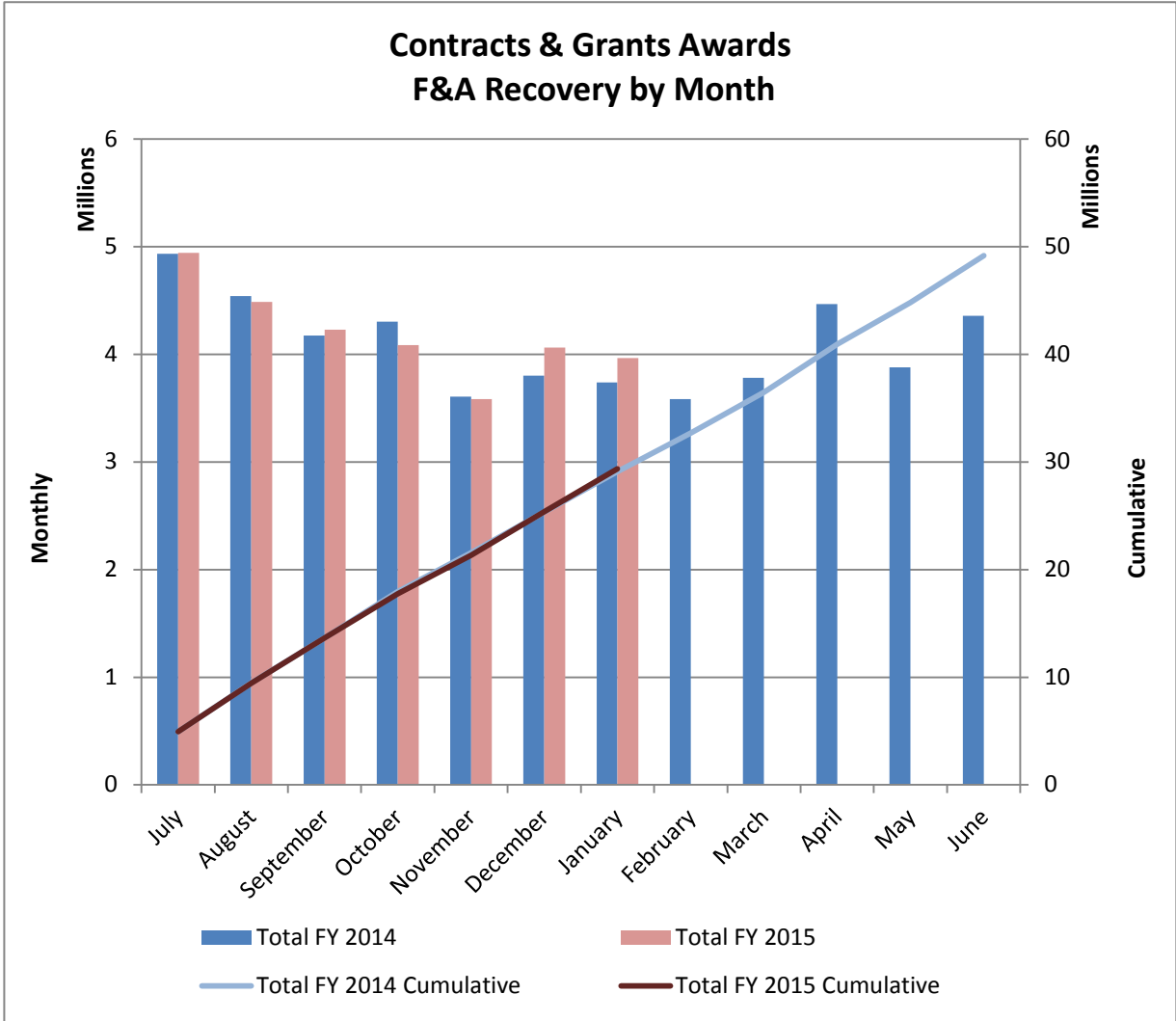

This blockage leads to hydronephrosis, which is the accumulation of urine in the renal pelvis causing buildup of pressure and a large distention of the kidney. The most common form of congenital obstructive nephropathy is ureteropelvic junction obstruction (UPJ obstruction), with an estimated incidence of 1 in 1000-1500, where the atresia is localized to where the renal pelvis connects to the ureter. Despite affecting so many children, we have a poor understanding of the molecular and genetic disruptions that result in UPJ obstructions, with very few non-surgical animal models. We, and others, have shown the eight-protein exocyst trafficking complex to be important in establishing and maintaining critical aspects of kidney tubular cells, such as tight cell-cell contacts, primary cilia, and cyst and tubule lumen formation. Sec10 is a central component of the exocyst complex, and we have recently finished generation of a new transgenic mouse strain to analyze in vivo consequences of tissue-specific Sec10 inactivation. We initially crossed this floxed-Sec10 strain with the Ksp-Cre mouse strain to induce knockout of Sec10 specifically in uroepithelial cells during development. We were surprised to observe nearly all the Sec10FL/FL;Ksp-Cre mice died quickly after birth, displaying severe bilateral hydronephrosis. Based on our preliminary analysis, we hypothesize that the conditional inactivation of the Sec10 gene in ureteric bud-derived epithelium causes congenital UPJ obstruction and hydronephrosis, sharing the pathogenic hallmarks observed in human</p>	1	76,250
