SUBJECT: Preliminary FY 2024 Fringe Rates Schedule for Use in Proposals

The preliminary FY 2024 composite fringe rates for use in proposals for University of Hawai'i (UH) employees can be found in the table below. We anticipate updating the schedule when the State negotiated rates are issued.

Please also note that the Other Post Employment Benefits (OPEB) rate is expected to be reinstated in FY 2024 (estimate is unknown). As a reference, the FY 20 OPEB rate was 12.45% per the State of Hawai'i Department of Budget and Finance's Finance Memorandum 22-07. A composite fringe rate with OPEB, assuming restoration of the FY 20 rate, is provided for your convenience.

NOTE: If the actual fringe rate for a UH employee is known, it should be used instead of these rates.

Refer to RCUH HR Policies No. 3.510 for estimated fringe benefit rates for RCUH employees.
