



Regents Policy Chapter 12, Research Regents Policy RP 12.206, Establishment and Review of Organized Research Units Effective Date: XXX Prior Dates Amended: Oct. 31, 2014 (recodified) Review Date: August 2019

I. <u>Purpose</u>

To set forth policy regarding the establishment and review of organized research units.

II. <u>Definitions</u>

No policy specific or unique definitions apply.

III. <u>Policy</u>

- A. The <u>bB</u>oard <u>of Regents ("Board")</u> approves extra-departmental administrative structures, commonly referred to as organized research units ("ORU"). ORU provides a locus for faculty, staff and students to engage in focused, collaborative research and training activities. <u>Organized research units may</u> <u>exist at the level of a School or college (Level V) or Department (Level IV).</u> They are supported in part by the Organized Research Budget (UOH 102) and <u>ORU-They</u> are expected to generate significant grant and contract funding.
- B. The <u>Pp</u>resident shall establish <u>rules and procedures for the establishment</u>, <u>review, and removal of review of proposed</u>_ORU, including<u>requirements for</u> review and recommendations by the relevant campus faculty senate and <u>administrative officers.administrators</u>.
- C. No organized research unitORU may not be formally established or discontinued until (1) review, as prescribed by the <u>Ppresident</u> has been completed; (2) the <u>Ppresident</u> makes a recommendation to the <u>Bboard; and (3)</u> and the <u>Bboard</u> has given its approval.
- D. Once established, an organized research unit will be reviewed periodically at intervals of seven years or less, according to procedures established by the president.

E. All major reorganizations of the administrative structure of an organized research unit must be in conformance with provisions of the board policy on establishment and reorganization of organizational units.
